**A RESOLUTION OF THE LAS ANIMAS COLORADO LIGHT AND POWER BOARD
CONCERNING A POLICY FOR TEMPORARY ELECTRIC SERVICE
CONNECTIONS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XXV of the Colorado Constitution, the City of Las Animas (the “City”) has the authority to establish and operate municipal utilities serving the City and pass rates, rules, and regulations governing the operation of those municipal utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Animas Light and Power Board (the “Board”) is authorized to enact administrative regulations for the City Light and Power Department; and

WHEREAS, the City need to clarify the regulations for temporary electric service connections; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to enact regulations concerning temporary electric service connections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LAS ANIMAS LIGHT AND POWER BOARD, THAT:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as if set fully forth herein.

Section 2. The following policy is enacted regarding temporary service connections:

Temporary Service

The following regulations are applicable to requests for temporary electric service:

- a. Inspections. Any temporary electrical service connection will require a State Electrical Inspection prior to connection. When an applicant requests conversion from temporary to permanent service, a second State Electrical Inspection is required prior to permanent release.
- b. Eligibility for Temporary Service. Temporary electrical service connections may be made prior to the installation of a permanent meter. Temporary electrical service connections will only be made for permanent and stationary structures. Camper, motorhomes, and other non-stationary and non-permanent structures shall not be eligible for temporary electric service.

- c. Duration. The duration of temporary electric service shall not be continued for a period longer than six (6) months. Any request for temporary electric service beyond six (6) months shall be made in writing to the Superintendent of Light & Power and such request shall be decided in the sole discretion of the Superintendent of Light and Power.

Section 3. The City is authorized to codify the ordering clauses of this resolution into a utility policy encompassing all of the Light and Power regulations.


Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
